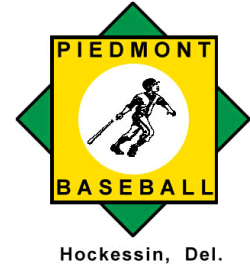


PIEDMONT BASEBALL CODE OF CONDUCT



Article II, Section 1 of The Piedmont Baseball League Bylaws states:

The objective of The Piedmont Baseball League shall be to implant in the children of the community that participate in the league the ideas of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority. To achieve this objective, The Piedmont Baseball League will provide a supervised baseball program. All Directors, Officers and Members shall bear in mind that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or the winning of games is secondary and the molding of future citizens is of prime importance.

In support of the bylaws, the following code of conduct will apply:

I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every practice, game or other sporting event.

I will be mindful of the need for player development over the need to win. I will appreciate a good play regardless of who makes it.

I will not taunt, jeer or attempt to distract the members of the opposing team.

I will avoid the use of profanity and derogatory or disrespectful yells, chants, songs or gestures.

I will not publicly criticize the coaches, athletes or umpires for the loss of a contest.

I will demand and demonstrate a healthy sports environment by refraining from drug, alcohol and tobacco use during all sporting events.

Let the kids play. Let the coaches coach. Let the officials officiate. It is your job to watch. Be a spectator, not a spectacle. There are consequences and sanctions that will punish poor behavior. Don't be an example of how they work.
